- YOUTH CAREER PROJECT/GLOBAL YOUTH SERVICE WEEKEND, APRIL 2013 providing education and job opportunities through an annual job skills workshop and job fair to over 300 youth; and a community service project
- Business Seminar Series, ongoing providing education through a quarterly series to approximately 150 business leaders annually
- TECHNOLOGY PROJECT, ONGOING continuing an upgrade of Chamber technology and providing education in technology for the general public, youth and senior citizens since spring 2008
- ONLINE JOB BANK connecting job seekers to employers online
- YOUNG ENTREPRENEUR PROGRAM
